



Dear Co-op Family,

Child (Student) Immunizations & Health Info:

Please submit the health packet including the doctors physical form & copy of current immunization record (registration packet).

California Legislation SB 277: This law, in effect January 1<sup>st</sup> 2016, eliminates the personal belief exemption.

Parent Volunteer Immunizations:

Per California Legislation SB 792, effective September 1, 2016, all adults employed or volunteering, over the age of 18, will be required to have certain immunizations, in order to provide care and supervision to children in group care. The Redding Co-op requires that at least one parent will be working in a volunteer capacity, on a regular basis, when their child is in school. More than one parent (or grandparent) may share volunteer responsibilities, but all “working” at the co-op must have written proof of the 4 immunizations below.

- MMR
  - Tdap (within 10 years of enrollment date)
  - Influenza (dated August-December of enrollment year. May be submitted through December)
  - TB Clearance (within 2 years of enrollment date)
1. Provide written proof of current immunizations. If you don't have a record, try contacting your high school or public health for a copy
  2. If records are not available or not current, get immunized at your physician's office, public health or a participating drug store pharmacy
  3. A blood test can be taken (Titer) at many physician's offices to determine immunity.
